You can't miss the disruption of the spiritual, the emotional, the intellectual, the physical, and the social in the story:

- » **Spiritually** they hid from God.

- » Socially they blamed each other and other things for the situation.
- » Emotionally they ignored the real emotions of the failure. And so the image of God in man was marred.
